PROGRAM INCENTIVES FOR KANSAS SHRM CHAPTERS

\$250 CHAPTER GRANT

- Grant available for each chapter event hosted for the purposes of promoting the HR RAP program (limit 2 events per chapter)
 - Attendee list shared with Navigator
 - Events including more than 50 people eligible for additional \$250 in assistance, if needed
 - Grants based on available funding

\$500 BUSINESS REFERRAL AWARD

- Award available to the chapter for each referred business enrolling in the HR RAP Program
 - Awarded once business is successfully enrolled in the program (one grant awarded per business)
 - Chapters recruiting businesses will need to submit information to HR RAP Navigator through direct contact report for chapter credit
 - Grants based on available funding
